```
table {  
  border: dashed blue 1px;  
  background-color: yellow;  
  width: 60%;  
}
```

2. What is missing from this?

```
BODY  
{  
  background-color: red;  
  color: #0000ff;  
}
```

3. Embedded styles are in the `<STYLE>` tag, which is a child of the `<HEAD>` tag, which is a child of the `<HTML>` tag.

4. What do the letters CSS represent? **Cascading Style Sheets**
