



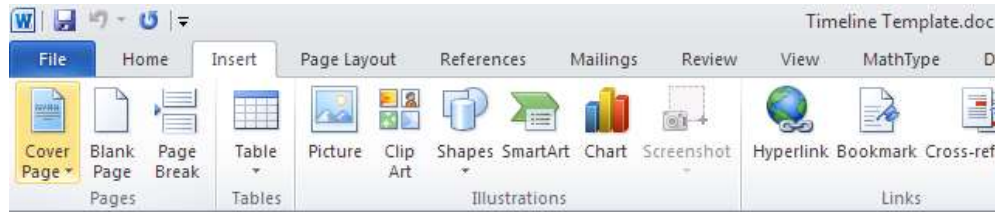
## The Timeline Project

### Step 1:

Save the [template](#) files into your H: drive.

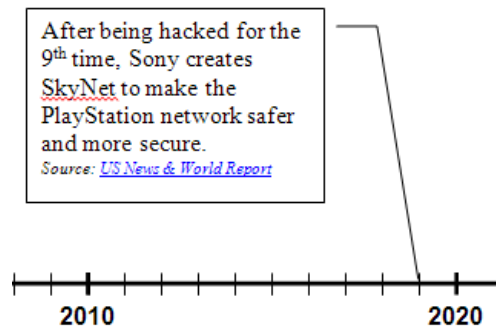
### Step 2:

Find the Insert tab in the Microsoft Word ribbon.



### Step 3:

Add Callouts to the timeline by choosing Shapes → Callouts. Use the type of callout you prefer, but be consistent. Here is a fictitious example:



### Step 4:

Each callout should include the description of an event in the past, present, or future. Events should be things such as hardware developments or releases, software or game releases, achievements of important game developers or computer scientists, or related technological advances.

Your timeline should include 1 event **per decade**.

Your timeline should include 2 images related to the events on your timeline.

The source of most items is listed.

At least 1 external source has been used.
